



3-Tier Anti-Trafficking Engagement List

The 2 main Anti-Trafficking initiatives Corps participate in yearly are: The Global Day of Prayer in September and the WRAP Campaign in October. This list is to inform and inspire Corps on how to continue to Fight for Freedom.

SA Justice is here to equip you! Once you pick an item from the list, let your territorial anti-trafficking rep know, and we'll send you the best resources and/or guide you in the right direction.

Tier 1

[Prep time: 10 - 15 mins]

- Begin to pray and become educated
- Put awareness posters up in your building or community
- Begin purchasing Fair-Trade coffee for the Corps
- Display SA Justice Buttons with the National Human Trafficking Hotline number: 1-888-3737-888
- Promote SA Justice's Anti-Trafficking programs on Social Media
- Have your Corps write encouraging letters for survivors and send to local program
- Designate a local SA Justice advocate at your Corps
- Write an object lesson for Sunday sermon
- Show awareness video to your congregation

Tier 2

[Prep Time: 4-8 hours // One time engagement]

- Host an awareness night
- Host a city prayer breakfast at your Corps
- Lead a Freedom walk in your community
- Host a Documentary Screening
- Host a Valentine's Day flash mob to raise awareness for fair trade
- Host a donation drive for an Anti-Trafficking Program
- Ask AHT program closest to your corps what they are needing
- SA Justice troop badge

Tier 3:

[Ongoing effort, more involved]

- Volunteer at your local program
- Request a training for your community
- Host a BRAVE event
- Join your local Task Force. If there is not one in your community, start one with other stakeholders in area
- Start a SA Support Team or other outreach effort
